USES:

For repairing minor damage to broken edges or corners of stone. Maximum patch size is ± 2 ".

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Surface to be patched must be completely clean and free from foreign materials. (Patcher will not bond properly to stone treated with sealers, etc.)
- 2. Wet area to be patched. (Stone which is too dry will absorb moisture from patcher and prevent proper cure.)
- 3. Mix patcher by adding clear water a little at a time until reaching a mortar-like consistency. (Do not add any more water once patcher has begun to set up.)
- 4. Apply patcher slightly heavier than the area to be patched.
- 5. Let dry for a minimum of 24 hours.
- 6. Area may be sanded after patcher has cured.

NOTE:

- Do not apply patcher when temperature is below 50° f.
 Patcher must not be subjected to freezing temperatures until it is completely cured.
- Do not mix any more patcher than you will use in a short time - as it sets quickly.
- Product shelf life is approximately 1 year if stored in a cool, dry place, and in tightly closed original containers.
